

**Notice of a Change in the Tariffs**

**You are hereby notified that the above named Association proposes to make the following changes to its General Rules and Regulations, to become effective December 1, 2009.**

**Section IX. Consumer Deposits**

The Association will require a cash deposit from all consumers and prospective consumers to guarantee the payment of electric bills. This deposit will be waived for those consumers with acceptable credit history with the Association, an applicant with acceptable credit history from a previous utility, and for residential applicants with an acceptable risk assessment score from a consumer credit reporting agency. An acceptable credit history is defined as no late payments in the last twelve (12) consecutive months.

For Residential Rate consumers, the deposit required will be the greater of \$150 or an estimate of three (3) months average billing, to be returned to the residential consumer as a credit to the consumer's account upon termination of service or when credit history reflects no payment received after the due date in the previous twelve (12) months, whichever occurs earlier.

For Commercial Rate consumers, the deposit required will be the greater of \$150 or an estimate of three (3) times the highest monthly billing, to be returned to the commercial consumer as a credit to the consumer's account upon termination of service.

**Section XI. M. Residential Budget Billing Plan**

A Residential Rate consumer may elect to enter the budget billing plan at any time, provided the consumer has either been served by the Association at the current residence for a period of not less than twelve (12) consecutive months prior to applying for this plan, or agrees to base the budget billing amount on the previous tenant's billing history. The consumer account must reflect no outstanding amount owed and no payments received after the due date in the previous twelve (12) months.

***Anyone who desires to comment on the proposed changes shall file a written response with the Association at the above address within ten (10) days before the proposed effective date.***

***The Association may hold a hearing to determine what changes will be authorized. The changes ultimately authorized may or may not be the same as those proposed and may include changes different than those tariffs proposed or currently in effect. Anyone who desires to receive notice of a hearing, if any, shall make a written request therefore to the Association, at the above address, at least ten (10) days before the proposed effective date.***
